COVID-19 Infection Control and the Notice on Exhibition

In response to care for COVID-19 infection, we will work with Pacifico Yokohama, the venue of this exhibition, to prevent the spread of infectious diseases and hold the exhibition as scheduled. The main measures currently planned are as follows,

■ Response during the exhibition period

- Install an alcohol disinfectant at each entrance / exit
- Signboards to alert cough etiquette, gargle and washing hands
- Install a sign that recommends wearing a mask
- Establishment of a rescue room with resident doctors and nurses
- Temperature measurement by thermography

* If a body temperature exceeding the specified level (assuming 37.5 degrees or higher) is detected, a doctor/nurse will conduct a consultation, and in some cases, entry to the exhibition may be refused.

■ Future measures

We will notify additional infection prevention measures and influence of any changes in the infection situation on the holding of the exhibition on the official exhibition website or by e-mail at any time as soon as there are changes.
